 <p>Paper</p> <p>Mixed Paper Newspapers Inserts</p> <p><i>NOT ACCEPTED</i> Tissues Paper Cups, Towels, Plates Most Paper Wrappers Photos Brightly Colored Paper Very Dark Paper</p>	 <p>Books</p> <p>Phone Books Magazines Catalogs</p> <p>Remove hard covers</p> <p><i>NOT ACCEPTED</i> Hardback Books Tyvec Envelopes</p>	 <p>Cardboard</p> <p>Cardboard should be broken down, flattened and cut up or folded into pieces no larger than 24 inches by 24 inches</p> <p><i>NOT ACCEPTED</i> Waxed Cardboard TIP: If you can see or feel waxy residue when you scrape a box with your fingernail, it is waxed. Oversized cardboard* Intact cardboard boxes* *These do not fit in the recycling section of the truck</p>
<p>How to Recycle</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Tie bundle with string or place in a paper bag 2. Set curbside for scheduled pickup

 <p>Plastics</p> <p>1 PETE 2 HDPE 4 LDPE 5 PP OTHER</p> <p><i>NOT ACCEPTED</i> Containers smaller than 2" x 2" Containers larger than 2 Gallons Styrofoam Plastic Bags</p>	 <p>Metals</p> <p>Aluminum Cans Aerosol Cans Steel Cans</p> <p><i>NOT ACCEPTED</i> Bulky Scrap Metal</p>	 <p>Glass</p> <p>Clear Brown Green</p> <p><i>NOT ACCEPTED</i> Candle Jars Casserole Dishes Ceramic Dishes Vases Glasses Light Bulbs Windows</p>
<p>How to Recycle</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Rinse to remove food residue 2. Place in recycling bin 3. Set bin curbside for scheduled pickup <p>TIP: Caps and labels do not need to be removed!</p>
