Do not begin project until written approval is received from the City of Cumberland.
A signed and 'approved' stamped form is required for application to be considered complete.
This will be sent to you upon approval of the department manager or designated representative.

I understand that I am responsible to have all applicable (rough-in and final) Plumbing and Electrical Inspections conducted through an independent, licensed Maryland State approved inspection agency.
